Day 1 – Ulaanbaatar Arrival

Welcome to Mongolia! Your journey kicks off at Chinggis Khaan International Airport. Once you've cleared immigration and grabbed your bags, look for your friendly local guide and driver waiting for you in the arrivals hall. They'll whisk you away for a smooth transfer to your hotel in the heart of Ulaanbaatar. Depending on your arrival time, you may have free time to rest or explore the city. enjoy a welcome dinner at a local restaurant. This will be your official introduction to authentic Mongolian cuisine. After dinner, return to your hotel for a comfortable overnight stay.



Day 2 – Terelj national park

After breakfast, visit the Chinggis Khan Museum to discover the history and legacy of Mongolia's greatest leader. Continue to Gorkhi-Terelj National Park, famous for its dramatic granite formations and scenic landscapes. Stop at Turtle Rock and enjoy a horseback riding experience through the valley. Later, hike to Aryabal Meditation Temple for panoramic views of the surrounding mountains.

In the afternoon, attend a traditional nomadic cultural presentation where you will learn about Mongolian ger life, dairy production, and local customs. Meet eagle hunters and discover their unique traditions before checking into the tourist camp for dinner and overnight stay.



Day 3 – Khar Zurkhnii Khukh Lake

After a leisurely breakfast at 9:00 AM, we'll embark on a scenic journey to the stunning Khar Zurkhnii Khukh Lake (Blue Lake), a place deeply connected to the early life of Temujin, later known as Chinggis Khan. According to history, after fleeing from the Tayichuud, Temujin reunited with his mother and siblings near Burkan Khaldun Mountain before settling near this lake. It was also here that his eight horses were stolen, leading him to meet Boorchi, who later became his trusted ally and played a key role in the founding of the Mongol Empire. This is also believed to be the place where Temujin was proclaimed Khan of the Mongols.

Surrounded by majestic forested mountains, the lake is known for its peaceful atmosphere, rich wildlife, and natural beauty.

Our first stop will be at Tsonjin Boldog around 11:00 AM to visit the world's largest equestrian statue of Chinggis Khan. We'll then continue to Baga Nuur village for a traditional Mongolian lunch before arriving at Khar Zurkhnii Khukh Lake around 4:00 PM. After checking into the tourist camp, you'll have free time to relax and enjoy the tranquil surroundings before dinner and overnight stay at the camp.



Day 4 – Binder Village

After breakfast at 8:00 AM, we'll depart for Binder village, stopping for an early lunch in Omnodelger soum along the way.

Today's journey takes us through the historically significant Khorhkhonug Jibur Valley. After the Merged tribe kidnapped his wife Borte, Temujin joined forces with his childhood friend Jamukha and Tooril Khan to rescue her. Following their victory, Temujin and Jamukha lived together in this valley for nearly a year, strengthening their friendship. It is also believed to be the place where they renewed their friendship for the third time by exchanging golden belts, one of which is now displayed at the Chinggis Khan Museum. The valley is also considered the birthplace of Zuchi, the eldest son of Chinggis Khan.

In the afternoon, visit Rashaan Khad, an archaeological site featuring ancient rock carvings, inscriptions, and burial remains dating from the Stone Age to the Mongol Empire. Continue to Oglogchiin Wall, believed to be a royal Khitan-era cemetery from the 8th century.

Arrive in Binder village around 5:00 PM, check into the tourist camp, and enjoy dinner while relaxing in the peaceful natural surroundings.



Day 5 – Dadal Village

After a hearty breakfast at 8:00 AM, we'll head to Dadal village—widely recognized as the birthplace of Genghis Khan. Along the way, we'll stop to explore the scenic Pine Forest Corridor and the dramatic Yargui Cliff in Binder soum.

We'll then continue to Bayan-Adraga to visit the Hunnu Tomb at Duurlig Nars and the Mongol Queens' Palace Complex. At 1:00 PM, we'll enjoy lunch at a local restaurant.

In the afternoon, we'll arrive in Dadal village around 4:00 PM to visit Deluun Boldog—one of Mongolia's most significant historical landmarks. Believed to be the birthplace of Genghis Khan (Temuujin) in 1162, Deluun Boldog stands as a powerful symbol of national heritage. We'll also see the Genghis Khan Light Statue and explore the "Three Lakes" area, which holds deep connections to his early life.

At around 6:00 PM, we'll check into a nearby tourist camp, enjoy dinner, and relax for the evening, surrounded by the serene landscapes of Khentii Province



Day 6 – Chinggis City

After a hearty breakfast, we'll depart for Chinggis City, the capital of Khentii Province. Along the way, we'll visit the Shikhikhutag Complex in Norovlin soum, an important historical site linked to Mongolian nobility.

We'll then continue with Batnorov soum for lunch at a local restaurant around 12:00 PM. Afterward, we'll visit the Friendship Monument, which marks the location where the young Temujin, while searching for his stolen eight horses, first met Boorchii—who would later become one of his most trusted companions and generals.

By around 3:30 PM, we'll arrive in Chinggis City and visit the Khentii Province Museum to explore the region's rich history and cultural legacy. Later, we'll check into our hotel, enjoy dinner, and relax for the evening.



Day 7 – Return to Ulaanbaatar

After breakfast, drive back to Ulaanbaatar. Arriving in the afternoon, you will have free time to shop for souvenirs and explore local cashmere products. In the evening, enjoy a traditional Mongolian folk concert, experiencing authentic music and cultural performances, followed by a farewell dinner to conclude your journey.

Day 8 – Departure

After breakfast, check out from your hotel. Your guide and driver will transfer you to Chinggis Khaan International Airport for your departure flight.

Your unforgettable journey through the diverse landscapes, rich history, and nomadic culture of Mongolia comes to an end.

Travel guide & Tips

Mongolia is known for its vast landscapes and rapidly changing weather, so we recommend bringing comfortable outdoor clothing and dressing in layers. Even during summer, mornings and evenings can become cool, especially in the countryside. A light waterproof jacket, comfortable walking shoes, sunscreen, sunglasses, and a hat are highly recommended for outdoor activities.

While staying in ger camps and visiting remote areas, facilities may be simpler than in the city, but they offer an authentic experience of Mongolian nomadic life. Internet connection can be limited outside Ulaanbaatar, so preparing offline maps or essential information in advance can be helpful.

Mongolian people are known for their warm hospitality, and guests are always welcomed with respect.

When visiting monasteries or nomadic families, modest clothing and respectful behavior are appreciated. Horseback and camel riding activities are suitable even for beginners, and local guides will assist you throughout the experience.
